Syllabus

The NEBOSH Certificate is divided into two units IG1 and IG2 which are assessed separately:

IG1 is broken down into four elements made up of:

- Element 1:** Why we should manage workplace Health and Safety
- Element 2:** How Health and Safety Management Systems work and what they look like
- Element 3:** Managing risk - understanding people and processes
- Element 4:** Health and Safety monitoring and measuring

IG2 is a practical risk assessment exercise demonstrating an understanding of elements 5-11 including:

- Element 5:** Physical and psychological health
- Element 6:** Musculoskeletal health
- Element 7:** Chemical and biological agents
- Element 8:** General workplace issues
- Element 9:** Work equipment
- Element 10:** Fire
- Element 11:** Electricity

What kind of people take the NEBOSH International General Certificate?

Managers, supervisors and staff from all types of organisations who need a broad understanding of Health and Safety issues. Many people take the NEBOSH International General Certificate as a first step on a career in Health and Safety.

The new NEBOSH International Certificate focuses on the role of a real-life Health and Safety professional. It looks at the real, everyday risks that people encounter and how to manage them to help protect people and profits.

What are the benefits for the organization?

Many large organisations choose the **NEBOSH International General Certificate** as a key part of their supervisors' or management development program. You will develop the essential Risk Management skills to create a safe and healthy workplace, and, you will have the foundation knowledge to make recommendations to your employer to help them improve Health and Safety Management.

Smaller organizations, operating in lower risk environments, often choose the **NEBOSH International General Certificate** as the appropriate qualification for the manager taking the lead on Health and Safety issues.

What is the duration of the course?

Duration - 10 days

IG1 - 4 Days

IG2 - 6 Days

What does the qualification cover?

The NEBOSH International General Certificate covers the main legal requirements for Health and Safety, identification and control of workplace hazards and the practical application of this knowledge. The syllabus is mapped according to the International Occupational Standards for Health and Safety.

What are the Course entry requirements?

Previous Health and Safety knowledge or experience is not essential to take the course. But you will need to have a good level of English to be able to understand complex concepts and discuss them in your exam.

Is the NEBOSH International General Certificate a recognised qualification?

The NEBOSH International General Certificate is accepted by IOSH, the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health as meeting the academic requirements for Technician Membership of IOSH (Tech IOSH). It is also accepted by The International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) for associate membership.

How is the course assessed?

Candidates are assessed with examinations for each of the two NEBOSH IG Units as follows:

IG1- Management of International Health & Safety

IG2- Risk Assessment

Assessment Methods

IG1- An online open book examination, examining the topics covered in Elements 1-4

IG2- A 3 hour practical Risk Assessment carried out in the workplace, which will demonstrate the learners knowledge of workplace hazards and risks covered in Elements 5-11

A unit certificate is issued denoting successful achievement of each unit.

If any learners want to do a resit, we can register

them on an open book exam for the old IGC1. These are likely to be held monthly from September 2020. This will be followed up with a professional discussion/interview held via Zoom/Skype. If a learner wants to resit the old GC2, this has to be done on a standard date examination sitting. These dates are in March, June, September and December each year.

The number of participants does not exceed 20 individuals, to optimize interaction during the course.
